



Silky and perfumed, the 2019 offers gorgeous floral intensity to play off a core of dark red-fleshed fruit. This medium-body, savory Cabernet checks all the right boxes. It is quite impressive in this tasting.

A vast, expansive ranch, Star Lane is home to some of the finest Cabernet in Santa Barbara. I tasted a handful of prior vintages with winemaker Tyler Thomas, all of which appear to be built for the long haul. The Astral Cabernet, mostly from own-rooted vines, is the top wine here, while the straight Star Lane bottling remains one of the finest values in Cabernet Sauvignon.
